To the Waukesha Friedman Alley Mural Committee,

I am writing to express my heartfelt interest in contributing to the revitalization of Friedman's Alley. As a traveling muralist, I look for opportunities like this that allow me to use design and art to reflect the community in which it is placed.

You'll see in both my proposal and portfolio that I tailor my work to each location and community. I've included two proposals for your walls, but I believe the final design should grow from community input—because murals ultimately belong to the people who live with them every day.

The alley you presented has a unique visual essence on Main Street. Because of this, I believe the murals should go beyond static squares and rectangles, instead creating a natural flow that feels integrated with the space and draws both the eye and people into the alley. My proposal is designed to do just that.

While I often love to paint children, this location feels perfectly suited to the natural beauty of the area. I am proposing a mix of local wildflowers and native birds to soften the harshness of the concrete buildings. My current design includes Butterfly Milkweed, Liatris, Asters, and Rudbeckia, along with an American Crow, but I am happy to adapt the imagery to feature flowers and birds that the community feels are most meaningful.

In addition, while I feel strongly about my proposed designs for mural one and mural two, I would also like to offer ideas for mural three. I believe it would be especially appealing if the murals tied together, creating a cohesive visual story throughout the alley.

If selected, I will approach this project with humility, care, and a collaborative spirit. I would also welcome the chance to work with a local artist, as I recognize the impact of bringing in an artist from another town. This not only ensures that the project is rooted in the spirit of Waukesha, but also helps support and strengthen the local art community so it can continue to grow.

PROPOSAL 1





I am aware you asked for two murals on the forward side of 300 Main St.--one of 14'x14' above the awning (Mural Space 1) and another 10'x20' to the right of the awning (Mural Space 2); however, I think these spaces should be combined

and even flow under the fire escape, incorporating an additional estimated 10'x10' additional wall space. The overall shape of the mural would be a reverse S, allowing the eye to follow the flow into the walking area of the alley. While my proposal currently is only the natural aspects, additional colorful shapes and lines can be incorporated for more drama and can be seen in my second proposal.






PROPOSAL 2





My second proposal is similar to the first, but it incorporates colorful graphics in addition to the natural elements. This also will pull people into the alley, and--you could further

incorporate the 8'x14' space on the back of the building (Mural Space 3). As I love old buildings, I would love to see as much of it as possible, so I propse a cutout mural be installed. The blue squiggly line could be pulled to the back, and then twisted into a shape reminiscent of the parade memorial, and carried by red-winged blackbird, not just a common bird to the area, but one that symbolizes hope, protection, and transformation.







ESTIMATED BUDGET MURAL SPACE 1 and 2





Estimated time for these two mural areas is 1.5 weeks, depending on weather. I prefer painting directly onto the wall.

The difference between the first option and the second (with the colorful geometric graphics), will be about \$60 additional for supplies.

I will need to travel and lodge, but I am always happy to negotiate this or to have the city to provide housing with a donated hotel room or airbnb.

I carry 2 million dollars in general liability insurance.



I am a muralist dedicated to community engagement and the transformative power of public art. My work focuses on connecting with diverse audiences and contributing to cultural vibrancy. As a woman and mother, I have found that my approachable demeanor allows me to welcome spectators and share my creative process. I often invite onlookers to participate in the spray painting, fostering a sense of ownership and pride within the community.

Living with aphantasia—a condition where I cannot visualize images in my mind—I meticulously predesign my murals to ensure every detail is planned before painting begins. This approach facilitates clear communication with project committees, allowing them to fully envision and actively shape the design, making the artwork a true reflection of the community's collective input.

In my murals, I frequently depict children to evoke a sense of innocence and hope, aiming to inspire viewers across all age groups. Additionally, I incorporate ambiguous elements to encourage personal interpretation, inviting each observer to find their own meaning within the artwork.
