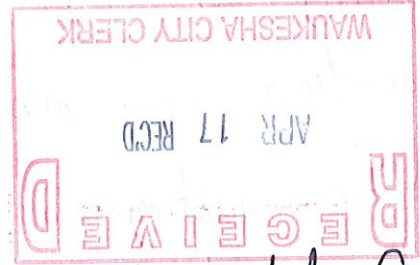

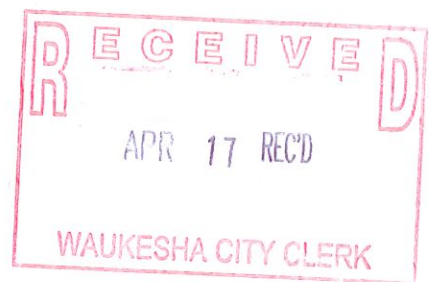


Driving friend home after getting diner. Waited for a break in the storm before starting the short drive to his house on Grandview Blvd. Headed northbound out of downtown Waukesha on Madison St.

Stopped @ the intersection of Madison, north, and Delafield to wait for red light. Watched city black squad turn left in front of me, then it was my green to go. Squad had just come down Madison southbound. Time is roughly 9:45 PM in lighter rain for the evening. Once we passed Randall and 3rd street on Madison it felt like we hit a ton of bricks. Car shook violently and we bounced a few times. I had seen nothing, my passenger had seen no road obstructions either. We got out and found the manhole cover 8 ft away from where it should be. My car was leaking gas, so we drove him home and then I went to D&D automotive off St. Paul.

Called city of Waukesha non-emergency line @ ^{10:16} ~~10:22~~ PM
from the bike-trip off of St. Paul while
waiting for my girlfriend to pick me up. Discussed
location of manhole cover and the incident.

After waiting a few more minutes I realized
they hadn't taken down any information about
me and had just said to get ahold of city
garage the next day. At the time that didn't
seem sufficient so I called them back
@ 10:32 PM. They re-iterated the instructions
and told me they had someone replace
the manhole cover I had hit. I was
skeptical, but am unable to validate if that
is true. Hung up and took my ride home
