Mixed use residential and commercial project

2417 Silvernail Road

Dear Mr. Koehler,

The project consists of redeveloping an existing commercial office site. The existing building and surrounding paved surfaces will be razed. The new building consists of mixed use. 50% of the 1st floor facing Silvernail Road will be commercial use. 76 multi-story residential units will be above the 1st level. A multi-level parking garage will be placed below the residential units and is on 3-levels including the 1st floor commercial space. The site slopes from Silvernail Road down approximately 16' to the south wetland rear yard. Site improvements include storm water detention, several open-air parking spaces, curbs, landscaping, site lighting, existing driveway replacement, and new utilities to replace the existing utilities.
