<p>Issue Before the Board/Council:</p> <p>The original policy was created to ensure that the City's website remains a reliable, neutral, and secure source of official government information and services. By restricting external links, the City wanted to minimize exposure related to inaccurate information, accessibility issues, advertising, or inappropriate content on third-party sites while also ensuring uniform standards.</p> <p>Following a comprehensive policy review, Human Resources and Information Technology have determined that oversight of this matter falls within IT's operational authority. Consequently, this topic has been formally incorporated into the IT Acceptable Use Policy, adopted in 2025. We are requesting to have it abolished/removed from HR policy oversight.</p>

<p>Additional Details:</p> <p>With the existence of the IT Acceptable Use Policy, the HR and IT departments want to abolish the B18 policy because it is outdated and no longer needed.</p>
